Description

The variable C_STATUS describes the status of every person (on the 1. January in a given year) in the C-family that the person belongs to.

C_STATUS can assume the following values

1	Single (man or woman)
2	Married woman
3	Married man
4	Oldest person in a civil partnership
5	Youngest person in a civil partnership
6	Cohabiting couple (with shared children)
7	Cohabiting couple (no shared children)
8	Child living at home
9	Child not living at home

In order to be a child who is living at home a person should be able to fulfill the following criteria:

1. To be the child of at least one person in the family (it is not possible to distinguish between biological children and adopted children) and have the same address as this or these person(s)
2. To be under 18 years old (in C-families) or under 25 years old (in E-families)
3. To be unmarried (the variable CIVST=U) which means that the person has never been married or been registered in a civil partnership
4. To have no children living at home
